

Fitting the gas canister into the Cobb Gas (Model PGA002/003/004)

- Use outdoors only.
- If there is a leak on your appliance(smell of gas),take it outside immediately into a well ventilated flame free location, away from people, where the leak may be detected and stopped.
- If you wish to check for leaks on your appliance, do it outside. Do not try to detect leaks using a flame, use soapy water.
- Check the seals before connecting a new gas container to the appliance.
- If you detect a smell of gas, ensure the regulator knob is in the off position. Unscrew the gas canister, turning the canister to the left (anti clockwise) prior to reconnecting. Be certain the canister threads are not cross threaded and ensure that seal is correctly seated. Do not use an open flame to check for leaks.
- Check that the regulator "O" ring is in place and not damaged. See Diagram A.
- Change the gas container outside and away from people.
- Do not incinerate or puncture the canister even if empty.
